## Documents Needed to Prepare FAFSA

Parents and students should bring their latest tax information and/or last pay stub from the previous year in order to complete the form. **(So to attend college 2011-2012, you will need 2010 tax records).**

Keep these records! **You will not mail your records to Federal Student Aid.**

- Social Security Number (can be found on Social Security card)
- Driver's license (if any)
- W-2 Forms for the previous year and other records of money earned
- Your (and your spouse's, if you are married) most recent Federal Income Tax Return:
  - IRS Form 1040,
  - 1040A,
  - 1040EZ,
  - 1040Telefile,
  - foreign tax return, or
  - tax return for Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia.
- Parent's Federal Income Tax Return for the previous year (if you are a dependent student as defined by federal criteria)
- Untaxed income records for the previous year:
  - Social Security,
  - Temporary Assistance to Needy Families,
  - welfare, or
  - veterans benefits.
- Child support records
- Worker's Compensation records
- Current bank statements
- Current business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stock, bond, and other investment records
- Documentation that you are a U.S. permanent resident or other eligible noncitizen (alien registration or permanent resident card).
